



## Which is the largest residence of any head of state of the world?

Yes, it's in our country itself. In terms of area, **Rashtrapati Bhavan** in Delhi is the largest residence. It's name was given by **Rajendra Prasad** who became the first President of India and occupied the building on 26 January 1950.

Last week, former **President Pranab Mukherjee passed away** at the age of 84 after undergoing surgery for a clot in the brain.

- His father, Kamada Kinkar Mukherjee, was a freedom fighter and Pranab started his career as a teacher.
- Major positions served by him include that of a Rajya Sabha Leader (1980-85), Finance Minister (1982-84 and 2009-12), Minister of External Affairs (1995-96 and 2006-09), Defence Minister (2004-06) and finally the President of India from (2012 - 2017) wherein he rejected 30 mercy petitions of the likes of Ajmal Kasab and Yakub Memon.

## Part of the story is the end


We agree, Tony Stark. The highest grossing film of all time, **Avengers:Endgame** gets its name from **chess**, wherein 'endgame' is the **stage of the game** that has few pieces left on the board.

This week, **India and Russia** were declared the **joint winners** of the **44th Chess Olympiad 2020**.



- It was an event of many firsts as India won its first gold medal in the Chess Olympiad held online for the first time due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
- **Power Glitches**: Russia was initially declared the winner, but India filed an appeal for losing time due to a connection loss.

 One of the winners, Koneru Humpy: Became the youngest woman to achieve the grandmaster title in 2002, a record later broken by Hou Yifan in 2008. She also won the World Women's Rapid Chess Championship in 2019.

## **Ever travelled in a Shinkansen?**

The **Shinkansen** is the Japanese term for the **bullet train**, a network of high-speed railway lines in Japan.

 Derived from 'new trunk line', the word describe both the railway lines the trains run on & the trains themselves.



- Funded by Japan via a \$17 billion loan, India launched the bullet train project connecting
  Ahmedabad and Mumbai in 2020, which included a 'Transfer of Technology' to increase manufacturing in the nation.
- Last month, **PM of Japan Shinzo Abe** announced his **resignation**, citing poor health as the primary reason as he suffered from **ulcerative colitis** for years.

**Six Sigma** is a set of techniques and tools for process improvement in business and manufacturing.

Forbes awarded the Six Sigma certification to the Mumbai Dabbawala Association (MDA) in 2001 and declared dabbawalas' work 99.99999% accurate.



Prestigious institutions like **UC Berkeley** have their logistics system in their syllabus as 1 lunchbox passes through 6 delivery workers on average yet a rate of only 1 mistake in 16 million cases.
