

A Visit to NSE



At ISMS Students are exposed to the genuine challenges that businesses confront through field excursions. On industrial excursions, students may witness how different management concepts are implemented, which helps them better comprehend them.

Amitabh Pandey Training & Placement Cell of the International School of Management Studies, Pune, led an industrial tour to NSE Mumbai on July 26th, 2019. The goal of this tour was to educate students about various stock market trading options.

The National Stock Exchange (NSE) was established in 1992 to bring transparency to the Indian equity markets. NSE has 2500 VSATs and 3000 leased lines of communication across the country. The exchange offers trading, clearing and settlement services in equity, equity derivative, debt, commodity derivatives, and currency derivatives. The NSDL's security, combined with the transparency, lower transaction prices, and efficiency that NSE offered, greatly increased the attractiveness of the Indian stock market to investors.

The Visit began at 11 a.m. with an introduction session on the stock market, followed by a discussion on the importance of the stock market. The next illustrated how beginners should approach stock trading. The visit came to an end at 2:00 p.m.
